Our Philosophy


Our ideal is to design things that are simple enough to maintain programmatic relevance and preclude obsolescence. For us, a building is "simply" good when it optimally fulfills its functional requirements, is constructed in a way that makes sense, is built of appropriate materials, and credibly responds to the conditions of the place. Therefore we always try to formulate a few core questions that capture the essence of the design task.

We see ourselves as partners who devise responses in an environmental context. We believe that an architect's task lies foremost in turning ideas into reality: to do what is sensibly possible without losing the ability to consider the impossible. For us, architecture is not a question of style but a question of matching the form of buildings to the spaces we live in.

It is our unequivocal mission—in everything we design and build—to act in accordance with shared principles in terms of content and concept. We are committed to an approach we call "designing in dialogue." The approach could also be called dialectic in the sense of an imaginary interactive dialogue between the intellectual position of the architect and the parameters defined by the specific conditions. The Hamburg-based gmp Foundation was established in 2007 by gmp \cdot von Gerkan, Marg and Partners Architects for the professional development and training of students and graduates, as well as to encourage research in the fields of architecture, landscape architecture, and landscape conservation at home and abroad.

This mission is accomplished primarily through the Foundation's funding of the Academy for Architectural Culture (aac) in Hamburg.

In addition to providing teaching to highly gifted students and graduates in the field of architecture, the aac organizes a broad spectrum of public cultural and scientific activities in the form of lectures, podium discussions, symposia, et cetera, in order to promote and forge, in a direct and lively manner, closer links between architecture and the humanities as well as other cultural fields.

aac Academy for Architectural Culture

Architects occupy a special position in terms of social responsibility, because architecture is an art form that is applied in a social context and has social obligations. This understanding of architecture has been a key element of gmp's mission and work for over 50 years and has earned worldwide professional recognition for the practice.

The aac teaches architecture in dialogue—a discourse between architecture's requirements and the architects themselves. It is a feedback process in which both sides respond to each other and influence each other. Teaching at the aac is based on designing in dialogue. This assumes that architects represent society, not themselves. It also ensures that architects do not become entrapped in highly specialized positions by enabling them to develop conceptual architectural designs within much wider terms of reference.

Designing in dialogue makes it possible to handle projects lucidly, rationally, and appropriately from the initial design through to implementation; dialogue is never an end in itself, but completely oriented toward practical application.

Architects working on the international stage also need intercultural competence. That is one reason why the aac is internationally oriented, seeing intercultural exchange—the process of bringing different cultures closer together—as part of the expansion of the participants' cultural horizon. That applies to the architectural side as much as it does to mentalities, traditions, and social, political, and religious attitudes. Working together with fellow students from all over the world gives aac students the opportunity to tackle these issues directly. Openness in this respect is as important as architectural talent.

Meinhard von Gerkan Prof. Dr. h. c. mult. Dipl.-Ing. Architect BDA (1935–2022)

In 1965, together with Volkwin Marg, Meinhard von Gerkan founded gmp \cdot von Gerkan, Marg and Partners Architects. From 1974 to 2002, von Gerkan held the Chair of Architectural Design at the Technical University of Braunschweig. He was awarded an honorary doctorate by Philipps University in Marburg in 2002 and also by Chung Yuan Christian University in 2005. In 2007, the School of Design of East China Normal University in Shanghai awarded von Gerkan an honorary professorship and, from 2014 on, he was Advising Professor at Tongji University in Shanghai. Von Gerkan was a co-founder of the gmp Foundation and the Academy for Architectural Culture (aac), and he received numerous awards, including the Romanian State prize, the Grand Award of the German Association of Architects, the Federal Cross of Merit, 1st class, and the Liang Sicheng Prize of the Architectural Society of China. His best known projects include Berlin Tegel Airport, Berlin Central Station, Villa Guna in Jūrmala, Latvia, the Hanoi Museum, the Vietnamese National Assembly in Hanoi, the Grand Theater in Chongqing, the reconstruction and renovation of the National Museum of China in Beijing, and the master plan of Lingang New City near Shanghai.



Volkwin Marg Prof. Dr.-Ing. h.c. Dipl.-Ing. Architect BDA

In 1965, together with Meinhard von Gerkan, Volkwin Marg founded gmp · von Gerkan, Marg and Partners Architects. From 1979 to 1984 Marg was President of the Association of German Architects (BDA), and from 1986 to 2003 he held the Chair of Urban Design and Material Studies at the Faculty for Architecture at Aachen Technical University. In 2012, Hamburg's HafenCity University awarded him an honorary doctorate. Marg is co-founder of the gmp Foundation and the Academy for Architectural Culture (aac) for the advancement of young architects, and he has received numerous awards, such as the Fritz Schumacher Prize, the medal of the Freie Akademie der Künste Hamburg, the Grand Award of the Association of German Architects, the Federal Cross of Merit, 1st class, and the Mayor Stolten medal of the Free and Hanseatic City of Hamburg. Marg's best known buildings include the European Patent Office in Munich, the New Leipzig Trade Fair, the refurbished and re-roofed Olympic Stadium in Berlin, and the stadiums in Cape Town, Durban, Port Elizabeth, Brasília, Manaus, and Belo Horizonte for the FIFA World Cups in South Africa and


